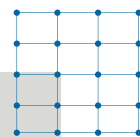

MSc in Cybersecurity Frequently Asked Questions



▶ What is the course schedule?

Classes are held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6 -10 pm.

▶ What is the fee?

The fees for 2025 are not confirmed. Please reach out to the team for more information. Payments are made on a yearly basis.

▶ Are instalment payments available?

We offer payment plans starting three months prior to the course commencement. However, all fees must be settled in full before the course begins.

▶ Are there any on-campus days?

This course is delivered entirely online, with no requirement for on-campus attendance, except for the optional Graduation ceremony, which can be attended either in person or online.

▶ What is the final award?

The final award is a Level 9 NFQ qualification, equivalent to 90 ECTS credits.

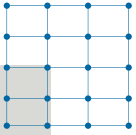
▶ What are the academic requirements?

Candidates should possess:

- A Level 8 Honours Degree in computing or a related field with a minimum of a 2.2 award or higher.
- Proficiency in programming.
- Non-English speaking applicants must demonstrate fluency in English, evidenced by achieving a minimum IELTS academic score of 6.0 or equivalent.

For those who do not meet the standard academic criteria, the college offers a Recognition of Prior Experiential Learning (RPEL) scheme. Applicants may be assessed based on relevant work experience and other qualifications through a portfolio submission, demonstration of work, and an interview. Additionally, programming proficiency will be evaluated during the assessment process

MSc in Cybersecurity Frequently Asked Questions



▶ Is there a requirement to complete an internship?

The internship runs over 15 weeks, in semester 4. It requires working full-time for the first 12 weeks in an ICT-related business environment. The last 3 weeks will be allocated for the preparation of the portfolio to be submitted. Students can undertake the Internship within their own company by being involved in a cybersecurity-related project.

▶ Is there tax relief if so, can you claim back any tax?

You may apply for tax relief however it is the responsibility of each applicant to contact the tax office. We can provide a receipt for fees paid if needed.

▶ What will the diploma state?

The diploma will indicate the completion of a Master of Science in Cybersecurity. However, it will not specify that the course was completed online.
