MSc in Data Analytics Frequently Asked Questions

What is the course schedule?

Classes are held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6-10 pm.

▶ What is the fee?

The fees for 2025 are not confirmed. Please reach out to the team for more information. Payments are made on a yearly basis.

Are instalment payments available?

We offer payment plans starting three months prior to the course commencement. However, all fees must be settled in full before the course begins.

Are there any on-campus days?

This course is delivered entirely online, with no requirement for on-campus attendance, except for the optional Graduation ceremony, which can be attended either in person or online.

What is the final award?

The final award is a Level 9 NFQ qualification, equivalent to 90 ECTS credits.

Is there a specific requirement for programming or development skills?

Yes, proficiency in programming is a prerequisite for this course. As it is a highly technical course, candidates are expected to demonstrate programming ability. MSc in Data Analytics, applicants should have completed at least two programming modules and two statistics modules. Typically, applicants would have experience with multiple programming languages rather than being limited to just one. However, each applicant is evaluated individually, and factors such as work experience are also taken into consideration during the assessment process.

What is the final award?

You may apply for tax relief however it is the responsibility of each applicant to contact the tax office. We can provide a receipt for fees paid if needed.

Is there a specific requirement for programming or development skills?

The diploma will indicate the completion of a Master of Science in Data Analytics. However, it will not specify that the course was completed online.
