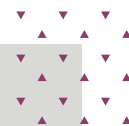

Important information to incoming students – please read carefully



- ▶ All modules must be completed to progress to year 2.
- ▶ Assignments must be submitted 4 weeks after they are handed out.
- ▶ Feedback and marks will be issued to students 4-6 weeks after submission.
- ▶ Modules can be repeated the following year at a cost to the student of €500 per module.
- ▶ Deferrals are only allowed for one year.
- ▶ If a student is unable to complete any of the above modules, we will issue an official withdrawal form.

### Late Submissions

All late submissions should be accompanied by an [EC1 form](#) for consideration.

The penalty for late submissions is as follows:

- ▶ Up to 24 hours after the original submission deadline date the penalty is 20%.
- ▶ Every subsequent 24 hours is an additional 20% will be deducted for up to 5 days.
- ▶ After 5 days it is deemed to be a non-submission. All submissions after this point may not be accepted or capped at 40% in line with General Assessment Regulations.
